NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY TO PARTICIPATE. PURCHASE WILL NOT IMPROVE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

1. **RAFFLE DESCRIPTION.** The “Custom Ruger 10/22 Rifle Raffle” consists of “Raffle Tickets” first released on December 15, 2011 and ending at 11:59:59 p.m. on 20 May 2012. The Raffle is not available to anyone without a legal residence within the United States or Canada. The Raffle is available in all fifty (50) United States and District of Columbia (collectively the “Territory”). Void where prohibited. Maximum number of physical Raffle Tickets to be released is three thousand (3,000) with an option to purchase additional tickets online. The “Official Raffle Computer” is the official timekeeping device for the Raffle. Except as otherwise stated, all times shall be United States Eastern Standard Time. A day is the 24-hour period starting at 12:00:00 midnight and ending the following 11:59:59 p.m. (a “Day”).

2. **WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO PLAY/TO WIN.**

A. **Eligibility:** The Raffle is open only to residents of the Territory. The Raffle is open only to residents of the US who must be at least eighteen (18) years of age or older on the day of drawing; Persons in any of the following categories are NOT eligible to participate: (a) any person who on 28 May 2012 is seventeen (17) years of age or younger; (b) is not a legal Territory citizen; (c) does not have a legal resident address; and (d) is not eligible to purchase a firearm under the states, territory or countries rules and regulations.

B. **Agreement To Official Rules:** The Raffle is conducted in the Wounded Warriors in Action Foundation (WWIA), (“Sponsor”) and, each person who plays the Raffle (each a “Participant”), unconditionally accepts and agrees to comply with and abide by these Official Rules and the decisions of Sponsor, which shall be final and binding with respect to all aspects of the Raffle in the Territory.

C. **To Be Eligible To Win:** Winning a prize requires that the potential winner of the prize is, and remains, in compliance with these Official Rules. Until such compliance is completed and verified as solely determined by Sponsor, the Participant is, and will remain, a potential prize winner.

3. **HOW TO OBTAIN A TICKET.** Official Raffle Tickets (each, a “Raffle Ticket”) can be obtained as follows, while supplies last (the following methods collectively referred to as “Legitimate Channels”) In Person, Mail-In Form, Online www.wwiaf.org (Official Website), Request without Donation: A Participant can request a Raffle Ticket without Donation by mailing a legibly handwritten, self-addressed, stamped envelope (“SASE”) with sufficient postage and a return address, including: (first and last name, street address, city, state, zip or postal code and stating that the Participant is requesting a “Without Donation” Raffle Ticket) to: Wounded Warriors in Action Foundation, 6516 Dolphin Cove Dr, Apollo Beach, FL 33572. **PARTICIPANT MUST ALSO PROVIDE A LEGIBLE COLOR COPY OF A PHOTO IDENTIFICATION (“Photo ID”) WITH ADDRESS, NAME AND BIRTH DATE** (to verify that the Participant is or will be eighteen (18) years of age at the time of the drawing) **MATCHING THAT OF THE PARTICIPANTS SASE.** One (1) Raffle Ticket will be mailed in response to each mail-in request that complies with the requirements of these Official Rules, while supplies last. One (1) Raffle Ticket per postmarked date per requesting participant SASE per day. Mail-in requests, including both outer envelope and SASE, must be handwritten. Outer envelope must include a return address in the upper left hand corner that matches the requestor’s street address, and must be postmarked no sooner than 15 December 2011 and must be postmarked by 20 April 2012 and received by Sponsor no later than 27 April 2012. Requests from Vermont (“VT”) residents that are postmarked in VT may omit return postage. Requests from VT residents that are postmarked outside of VT and omit return postage may be required to provide proof of VT residency to Sponsor's reasonable satisfaction before requests are fulfilled. Each request must be mailed in a separate stamped outer mailing envelope with the requestor’s first and last name, street address, city, state and zip or postal code (name and address must match the return name and address on SASE) legibly hand printed in the upper left hand corner of the outer envelope. Requests that are sent in

business reply envelopes, that utilize address labels or stickers (for any address), that are photocopied, hand-stamped, computer-generated or otherwise mechanically or digitally produced or reproduced, that are not mailed in separate outer stamped mailing envelopes, or that otherwise fail to comply with these Official Rules will NOT be honored, acknowledged or returned, and the persons submitting such requests will forfeit any corresponding postage and unused envelopes.

4. HOW TO PARTICIPATE. Once the Participant has obtained a Raffle Ticket(s) their information (which was obtained via the Legitimate Channels) is entered into the Official Raffle Computer. By 30 May 2012 the announced winner will be posted on the Official Website and notified.

5. Prizes.

A. Grand Prize: Fully customized, one of a kind, Ruger 10/22, .22LR caliber rifle, complete with variable Weaver mounted 3x9 Bushnell scope. Heavy duty barrel, serial # 259-76711 with inlaid WWIA coins, POW symbol, appropriately appointed with miniature skull cap mounted at end of stock.

Cash Option: At Winner's discretion, Winner may elect a cash payout of \$1500 cash.

B. Raffle Detail Odds: Those Raffle Tickets that have not been obtained by the Legitimate Channels will be excluded from the drawing.

C. Prize Odds: The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received. Decisions of the judges are final.

6. WINNER NOTIFICATION. Each winner will be notified by email or by phone, in the sole discretion of the Sponsor. If a potential winner fails to respond after two notices, his/her prize may be forfeited and an alternate winner may be selected.

7. PRIZE CLAIM DETAILS. Prizes can be picked up at WWIA Headquarters, 6516 Dolphin Cove Drive, Apollo Beach, FL 33752; Phone Number: 813-938-1390 or have Winners prize shipped to a local FFL dealer for a fee and shipping and handling. All prize claimants must be eighteen (18) years of age or older.

8. GENERAL PRIZE RESTRICTIONS. Prizes not claimed or that are forfeited will not be awarded. In lieu of the Prize the value of the prize will be placed into the Wounded Warriors in Action Fund.

9. VERIFICATION. Winning Raffle Tickets and Participant are subject to verification at Sponsors request and maybe verified by a duly authorized representative of Sponsor. PARTICIPANTS SHOULD NOT GIVE AWAY ANY POTENTIAL WINNING TICKET TO ANYONE. Raffle Tickets are null and void and will be rejected if not obtained through Legitimate Channels. If any part of any Raffle Ticket is counterfeited, illegible, mutilated, or tampered with in any way, if it contains or reflects printing, typographical, mechanical or other errors or discrepancies, or if it comes from other year, the Raffle Ticket will be deemed void. Each Participant acknowledges and agrees that the decisions of Sponsor shall be final, binding and conclusive in all matters relating to the Raffle, including without limitation determinations regarding the validity of Raffle Tickets submitted for verification. Except as specifically stated in these Official Rules, only original Raffle Tickets will be accepted for verification. Any person attempting to forge Raffle Ticket or defraud the Sponsor in any way in connection with this Raffle may be prosecuted to the fullest extent permitted under the law.

10. GENERAL RELEASE AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION. Participants assume all risk of loss, damage, destruction, delay and misdirection of Raffle Tickets and are advised to obtain insurance where appropriate. By participating in the Raffle each Participant hereby releases and agrees to hold the Sponsor and partners harmless from and against any and all costs, injuries, losses or damages of any kind, including, without limitation, property damage, death and bodily injury, (whether due to negligence or otherwise) due in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, to participation in the Raffle or any Raffle-related activity, or participation in any prize-related activities, or the receipt, use or misuse of any prize.

11. MISCELLANEOUS.

A. Disqualification: It is the Participant's sole responsibility to ensure that he or she has complied in full with all conditions and requirements contained in these Official Rules. If any potential winner is found to be ineligible, or if he or she has not complied with these Official Rules or declines a prize for any reason prior to award, such potential winner will be disqualified and the prize forfeited. No mechanically reproduced, illegible, incomplete, forged, software generated third party or other automated or robotic entries, in whole or in part, will be accepted. Entries made by any individual or any entity other than the Participant and/or originating by any other mechanism, including but not limited to commercial Sweepstakes subscription notification and/or entering services, will be declared invalid and disqualified for this Raffle. Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who is found to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Raffle; to be acting in violation of these Official Rules; or to be acting in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with the intent to disrupt or undermine the legitimate operation of the Raffle, or to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other person.

The Sponsor reserves the right to seek damages and other remedies from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law.

B. Force Majeure/Printing and Production Errors: Sponsor reserves the right, without prior notice and at any time, to terminate the Raffle, in whole or in part, or modify, suspend or extend the Raffle in any way, or deem the affected Raffle Ticket void and invalid if it determines, in its sole discretion, that the Raffle Ticket in question reflects printing or other errors or if it determines, in its sole discretion that the Raffle is impaired or corrupted or that fraud or technical problems, failures or malfunctions (including, without limitation, computer viruses or other deleterious programs or materials, glitches or printing or production errors) have destroyed or severely undermined Raffle Tickets, integrity, and/or feasibility of the Raffle. In the event the Sponsor is prevented from continuing with the Raffle as contemplated herein by any event beyond its control, including but not limited to fire, flood, natural or earthquake, explosion, act of God or public enemy, satellite or equipment failure, riot or civil disturbance, terrorist threat or activity, war (declared or undeclared) or any federal, state, provincial or local government law, order, or regulation, order of any court or jurisdiction, or other cause not reasonably within Sponsor's control (each a "Force Majeure" event or occurrence), then subject to any governmental approval which may be required, Sponsor shall have the right to modify, suspend, extend or terminate the Raffle. Only the type and quantity of prizes described in these Official Rules will be awarded.

C. Invalidity: The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of these Official Rules shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision. In the event that any provision is determined to be invalid or otherwise unenforceable or illegal, these Official Rules shall otherwise remain in effect and shall be construed in accordance with their terms as if the invalid or illegal provision were not contained herein. These Official Rules cannot be modified or amended in any way except in writing by the Sponsor a duly authorized representative of Sponsor, and may be done so without notification at anytime.

D. Governing Law: All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules or the rights and obligations as between Participant and the Sponsor in connection with the Raffle shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the internal laws of the State of Florida including procedural provisions without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules or provisions that would cause the application of any other state's or jurisdiction's laws.

E. Privacy: Information collected in connection with this Raffle may be shared with Sponsor's partners to the extent necessary to fulfill prizes. Information collected may also be used in future events related to the Wounded Warriors in Action Foundation.

12. OFFICIAL RULES. These Official Rules will be posted Online at the Official Website.
